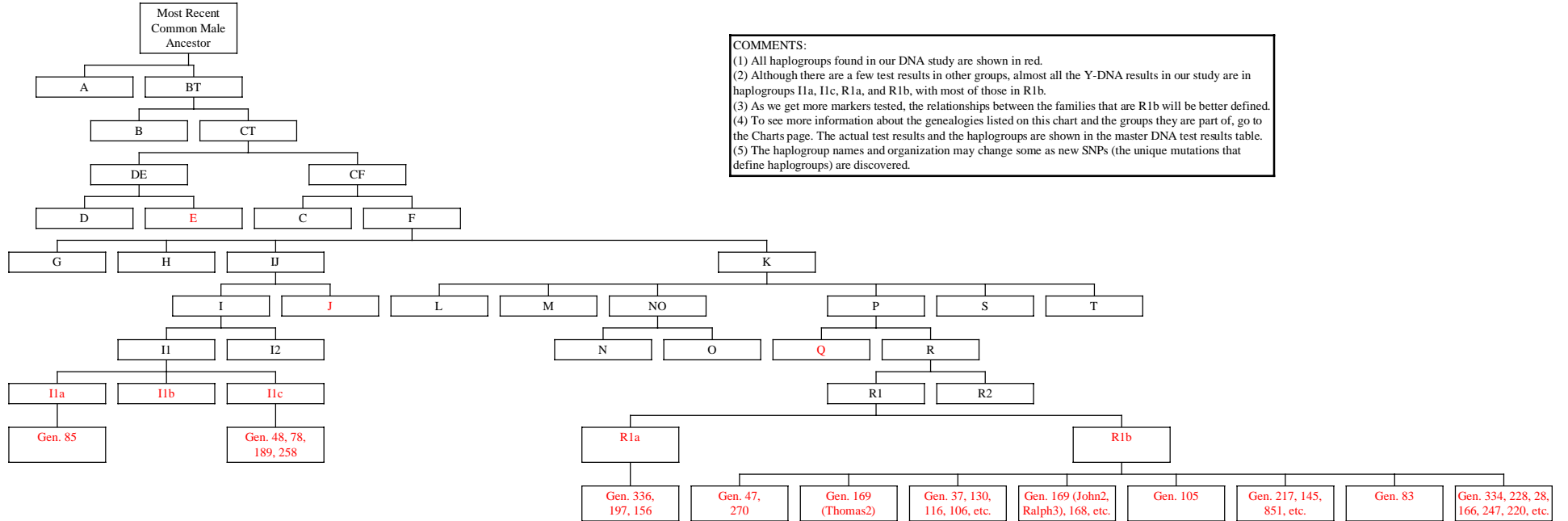


# Simplified Y-Haplogroup Chart

## Showing Relationships Between Tested Graves/Greaves Families

**COMMENTS:**

- (1) All haplogroups found in our DNA study are shown in red.
- (2) Although there are a few test results in other groups, almost all the Y-DNA results in our study are in haplogroups IIa, IIc, R1a, and R1b, with most of those in R1b.
- (3) As we get more markers tested, the relationships between the families that are R1b will be better defined.

- (5) The haplogroup names and organization may change some as new SNPs (the unique mutations that define haplogroups) are discovered.
